Cannabis importers allegedly held to different standards.

Responding to recent media reports regarding imported cannabis products, Biortica Agrimed CEO, Tom Varga commented, "Let's all just keep in mind what our priority is here. This is about providing the highest quality medicinal cannabis, affordably, to Australian patients in need."

"All medicinal cannabis needs to comply with TGO 93 and TGO 100 as a minimum. No ifs, buts or exceptions," he said.

"To patients and practitioners I'd say, look for the 'Product of Australia' logo as your guarantee of efficacy and safety."
